James 1:22

What's the point of learning something if you never use it?

God didn't give us the Bible just for information — He gave it for transformation.

James says:

“Do not merely listen to the word... do what it says.”

It's possible to hear sermons, attend church, know Bible stories, post Christian content ...and still not actually follow Jesus.

Real faith changes how we live. God's Word should affect:

- How we talk
- How we treat people
- What we watch
- What we value
- How we handle conflict
- How we respond under pressure

Reading the Bible without applying it is like reading workout instructions but never exercising. Spiritual growth happens when truth becomes action. Even small acts of obedience matter.
