Hey Families and Campers!

*Here is a list of recommended items to help you prepare for camp! We will Monday Morning at 10:00 am, and arrive back home Saturday afternoon. We will stay at camp for 5 nights and 6 days. **Please keep in mind, all clothing items will need to adhere to the Falls Creek standard of dress.***

Packing Checklist:

- Bible**, notebook, and pens
- Toiletries (shampoo, soap, DEODORANT, toothbrush, toothpaste, etc.)
- Sleeping stuff for twin size bed (sheets, pillow, blankets/sleeping bag. Cabin will be cold at night.)
- Clothes for 5 days (recreation, evening service, games). We will likely be playing some messy games so pack some clothes to get dirty.
- Shoes (include tennis shoes)
- Swim suit (**no two piece suits**)
- Great attitude, willing spirit, & an open heart
- Dirty clothes bag or trash bag
- Towels for showers (If your child is planning on swimming, a designated swimming towel is recommended.)
- Shower shoes (cheap flip flops)
- Water Bottle
- Any medicine needed (Please make contact with Blade prior to departure about **ANY** medication instructions.)

Optional items:

- Clear Bag for tabernacle**
- Wrist watch (No Smart Functions)
- Spending money
- Hats / Caps
- Flip flops
- Sun screen
- Umbrella or rain jacket

****Starting in 2026, only clear backpacks or clear large bags will be allowed-through bag check at the tabernacle and event center.**

Kids can bring neon and or camo clothes / Items to wear for the evening service. Any items that might cause a distraction will be left in the cabin during the evening tabernacle session. All clothing items must adhere to the Falls Creek dress code. We want this to be a light hearted fun thing for the campers, but don't want to distract from the purpose of evening worship.


Friday Night - Camp Family Night:

Dinner with your camp family group. We will wear our camp shirts to the evening tabernacle service.

FALLS CREEK YOUTH CAMP DRESS CODE

All apparel judgements will be left to the discretion of the Falls Creek Staff (FCS). If FCS determines a camper or campers should change their clothing to fall in line with camp requirements, then said camper or campers are required to do so.

ALWAYS ACCEPTABLE SHIRTS

Shorts must extend to or just beyond the campers' finger tips.

Sleeveless shirts must extend all the way to the shoulder seam.

Dresses/Skirts must reach the top of the knee.

Shoes must be worn at all times outside of your cabin.

Tights may be worn under a garment that meets the dress code. Tights/sliders do not extend the length of garments worn over them (short/skirts/dresses). **Tights are not pants.** No tight fitting or revealing clothing. This includes leggings or similar attire, which cannot be worn as pants.



DRESS CODE APPLIES TO THE 5K

SWIMWEAR

T-shirts and cover-ups must be worn to and from swimming venues.

male



Should wear swimwear of modest length (fingertip) and not tight fitting

female



Modest one-piece

male



No short shorts or tight-fitting shorts

female



No two-pieces

Campers may not be barefoot on the way to and from venues.

WHAT NOT TO WEAR



No tank tops or shirts cut down the sides.



Undergarments must always be covered by outer garments (i.e. no boxer shorts hanging out or bra straps showing).



No Midriffs/racer backs. No sport bras as tops (includes the 5K).



No spaghetti strap tank tops/dresses.

Apparel may not display tobacco, alcohol, controlled substances, or inappropriate language or pictures.

Dress Code Checklist

- No clothing with inappropriate writing, drug or alcohol advertising, etc.
- No midriffs.
- No tight fitting clothing (*This includes leggings/jeggings as pants. Should not be able to see the outline of the underwear.)
- All apparel must cover the shoulders. *NEW FC RULE*
- Skirts and dresses must be at least 4 inches from the top of the knee. (Sponsors are final judge on modesty.)
- Shorts must be EITHER fingertip length or 5 inch inseams!!
- No undergarments showing.
- Girls must wear a one-piece swimsuit when swimming. Must be covered when walking to and from swimming.
- Boys must wear t-shirts when walking to and from swimming.
- No shorts with writing on the backside.
- No tank tops for guys or girls. *Dress in a way to keep the focus on God, not you.

First Baptist Church Carnegie Camper Rules Checklist:

- Camper cell phones must be turned in - Sponsor Contact information is listed below
 - *Students will be allowed to use their phones during free time to make phone calls, but must be returned before leaving the common area of the cabin.*
- No weapons, drugs, tobacco, or alcohol.
- No profanity.
- No pranks, water guns, or water balloons.
- No PDA.
- No electronics. (**unless prescribed for medical needs*) -All non-essential electronics will be confiscated.
- No inappropriate magazines or reading materials.
- No one goes into the opposite sex's dorms.
- No stealing or taking of what is not yours.
- No food / water in the dorm rooms.
- Always be in groups of three or more from our church. (Must have four or more if boys/girls.)
- Be on time for everything.
- You have to take a shower **everyday**.
- When we play, we play. When we are serious, we are serious.
- Must respect all sponsors at all times.
