Calvary Chapel Distinctives

The following twelve distinctives have been adopted by Calvary Chapel as expressing the heart and aim of our ministry:

1. Calvary Chapel looks to the New Testament book of Acts as the divine model for the Church. We don't look to church history or movements, but rather to the Word of God.
2. Calvary Chapel has a basic form of leadership that is modeled after the theocracy of Israel as well as the insights of leadership in the New Testament. We believe the Pastor is to lead the church as he feels directed by the Holy Spirit with Elders coming alongside directing the affairs of the church. (1 Timothy 5:17).
3. Calvary Chapel recognizes the experience of the empowering work of the Holy Spirit as distinct and usually separate from the indwelling of the Spirit which occurs at the point of salvation.
4. Calvary Chapel practices a relaxed, casual style of ministry. (Although there's nothing casual about our faith in Christ.) We do not allow spiritual hype to motivate people, but rely on the teaching of God's Word coupled with the ministry of the Holy Spirit. We don't advocate church growth seminars or plans to make our church a user friendly atmosphere. We teach the Word and trust the Lord to add such as should be saved.
5. Calvary Chapel places a large emphasis on God's grace—recognizing that we are saved by grace and stand in grace.
6. Calvary Chapel seeks to declare the whole counsel of God ([Acts 20:27](#)) believing that the best program to achieve this is a systematic study of the entire Bible in an expositional manner.
7. Calvary Chapel emphasizes the centrality of Jesus Christ in all things. He is the reason we meet and the One Whom we serve. We seek to eliminate anything that places undue focus on anyone or anything but Christ.
8. Calvary Chapel is solidly pre-tribulational and pre-millennial in our eschatology.
9. Calvary Chapel believes in following the Spirit as He guides, rather than getting caught up in movements or the ruts of rituals and traditions.
10. Calvary Chapel believes in the supremacy of love—without which all the gifts of the Spirit are useless.
11. Calvary Chapel believes in a balance in approaching controversial but non-essential Biblical concepts, such of God's Sovereign election and man's responsibility, and the ministry of the Holy Spirit in the expression of spiritual gifts.
12. Calvary Chapel believes in taking ventures of faith. The way we discover how God wants to work is to step out and see what the Lord might do.
