



DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Read verses 15-16 out loud. It seems the Ephesians were known for their faith in God and their love for others. What are the things that you want to be known for?
2. Ask someone to read Ephesians 1:18 and John 1:5. In your own words, what does it mean to have your heart flooded with this light that shines in the darkness?
3. Look at Ephesians 1:19-20. Why is it significant that the power that raised Christ from the dead is available to you?
4. Read Ephesians 1:22-23. It can sometimes be discouraging to see our own brokenness or imperfections, as we are still very much in process of being sanctified.
Now, pretend you're speaking to a friend: How would you encourage someone else to trust that God will carry out His plan to make them full and complete in Christ?
