Quarterly Church Conference – Sunday, August 2
immediately following the worship service

Items for vote:
The **MMO Commission** proposes upgrading the playground fencing to a 6ft, aluminum, spear-top, commercial-grade fence. The total quote for the project is \$35,200.
\$10,000 will come from line item 6050 MMO Playground
\$25,200 will come from line item 1030 MMO Money Market
They hope to get this installed in August 2026.

The **Stewardship Team** will open the floor for questions & discussion on the revised fiscal policies during the August 2 church conference; these policies were handed out at the May 3 church conference. Copies are available in the vestibule or by contacting Jeff Jaeger. A vote on the revised fiscal policies will take place during the November 1 church conference.

The **Cemetery Team** Proposes having the following tasks performed at the church cemetery:
*Remove all shrubs and root balls at the front of the cemetery along Lake Wheeler Road, fill the area of the root balls with soil and grade as needed, and cover the area with pine straw.
*Repair the brick entry wall that was damaged several years ago.
*Have a 4' tall black aluminum fence installed at the front of the cemetery along Lake Wheeler Road, in three segments, with a total length of 120 to 126 feet.
These tasks will be performed for a cost not to exceed \$6,200.

Have you ever doubted that something important was true? After Jesus arose from the grave He appeared to His disciples several times. Once, He was on a mountain in Galilee. The eleven disciples gathered there and worshiped Him, but some “doubted.” “Doubt” means to waiver or be uncertain. They were uncertain as to who Jesus was.

Some scholars think that this mountain was the place where 500 disciples were gathered with the eleven and saw Jesus. If so, I am certain that there were people who doubted. When the women first told the disciples they had seen the risen Lord, even they did not believe them. When Jesus appeared in the upper room that first Sunday evening some of them did not believe and marveled. Thomas doubted Jesus was alive and said he would have to see Him with his own eyes and touch the scars in His body. But the doubts of these disciples were changed to faith when they saw Him and heard Him speak.

Jesus did not condemn them or belittle them for their doubts. He accepted them and taught them. At times, we all may have doubts concerning the truth of God’s word. Jesus still loves us and will continue to reveal Himself to us. As you continue to listen to Him and obey Him fully, you will find your doubts slowly being transformed to faith.
