



FAMILY CONNECTION

Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

SCRIPTURE

1 Kings 16:29-34; 18:15-19,36-39

SESSION SUMMARY

In this week's session, we looked at the story of Elijah calling fire down from heaven. Ahab and Jezebel led Israel to worship Baal, but Elijah would prove that the Lord is the one true God. Here are some of the main things we learned from the story in 1 Kings:

- Ahab leads Israel to worship Baal (1 Kings 16:29-34).
- Elijah challenges Israel to return to God (1 Kings 18:15-21).
- God proves He is the true God (1 Kings 18:36-39).

CONVERSATION QUESTIONS

- How can our relationships bring us closer or further away from God?
- What would it look like for our family to follow the Lord wholeheartedly (see 1 Kings 18:21)?
- What can learn from people like Elijah, who stood for God even when it was unpopular?

FAMILY CHALLENGE

Elijah had to be bold in his faith to stand up to Ahab, Jezebel, and the prophets of Baal. This week, create a skit together that teaches the idea of courage. Depending on the size of your family, you can either all work together or create two teams for two skits. After you have performed your skits, discuss various things that require courage. Here are some questions to help you with the discussion: How can each of us be more courageous in our faith? How can we be bold and loving at the same time? How might God want you to be bold this week?
