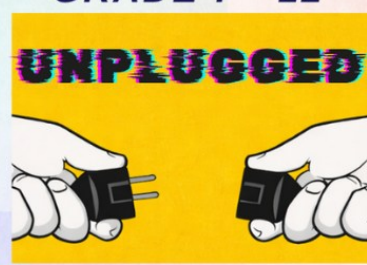

EXCEL in this Grace of Giving: 2026-2028

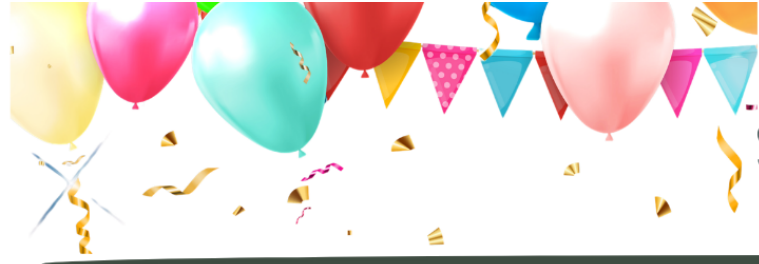

In May, I updated our elders on a few of the ministries I oversee, and now I want to share with you some great things our church is doing!

Seniors Ministry Highlights (September 2025 - April 2026)

- Mission & Vision in Action: Our Seniors Ministry fosters a multigenerational church body, supporting spiritual growth for older adults. This group excels at creating a caring, welcoming environment.
- Participation: Young @ Heart had 45-70 attendees monthly. Senior trips ranged from 7 to 20+ attendees.
- Leadership: Volunteers exceeded 20, contributing in roles such as presenters, devotion leaders, kitchen helpers, and event planners. Linda Ethell, Laura Menghini, and Carol Basso emerged as key leaders.

ACC Outdoors - Archery Ministry (April 2025 - March 2026)

- Mission Impact: Engaging children to seniors (averaged 70 per week), archery events reached over 104+ unique participants. Weekly devotions and consistent volunteers demonstrate intentional engagement.
- Leadership Growth: The team includes over 15 dedicated volunteers.
- Spiritual Connection: Relationships are forming through regular contact, with some archery families beginning to attend church services.

ACC Outdoors - 9th Annual Sportsman's Dinner (March 2026)

- Mission Fulfillment: We had 321 in attendance; more than 60% were guests. The Gospel was clearly presented.
- Leadership Growth: We had over 40 volunteers serve to make this night a success!
- Spiritual Response: 3 baptisms that evening, 3 in the following Sundays!

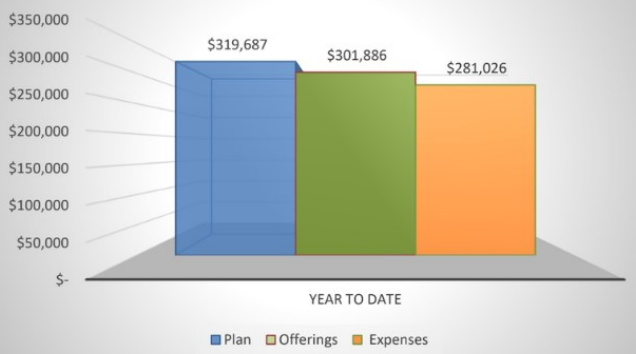

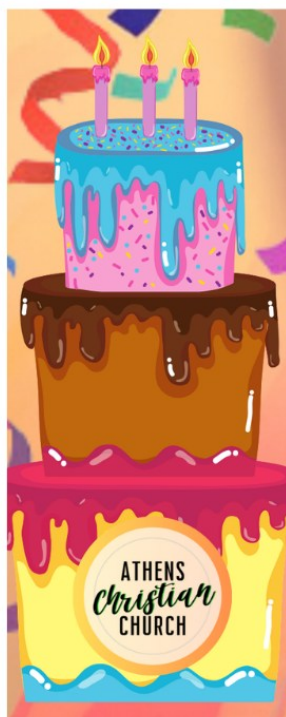
