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Romans 10:9-17

1. When people hear the phrase "saved by faith," what do you think they usually imagine faith is?
2. Why do you think so many people struggle with questions like, "Do I have enough faith"?
3. Romans 10 shows that people can trust in the wrong things. What are some things people today depend on to make them feel good enough or secure?
4. Faith is not mainly about emotional certainty, but about trusting Jesus. How might that change the way someone views their doubts, fears, or spiritual struggles?
5. **Read Romans 10:9-13.** The original Greek emphasizes the repeated words "everyone," "all," and "whoever." Why do you think Paul keeps emphasizing that?
6. **Read Romans 10:14-17.** According to these verses, where does faith come from? Why is that important for someone who worries that their faith feels weak?
7. Sometimes people look inward trying to figure out if their faith is real enough. What does it practically look like to focus more on Jesus than on yourself?

How would it affect a person if instead of worrying about their faith they would simply focus on the One their faith is in?

Bible Reading for Today

Romans 10:9-17

⁹ If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. ¹⁰ For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved. ¹¹ As Scripture says, "Anyone who believes in him will never be put to shame." ¹² For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on him, ¹³ for, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."

¹⁴ How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? ¹⁵ And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"

¹⁶ But not all the Israelites accepted the good news. For Isaiah says, "Lord, who has believed our message?" ¹⁷ Consequently, faith comes from hearing the message, and the message is heard through the word about Christ.
