Group Questions | Mission Builders

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Matthew 6:19-24

1. Sometimes *how* you do something is just as important as *what* you do. Why is that the case?
2. **Read Matthew 6:19-20.** Jesus contrasts storing up treasures on earth with storing up treasures in heaven. What are some ways we can tell which kind of treasure we're actually investing our lives in?
3. Jesus said, "Where your treasure is, there your heart will be also" (Matthew 6:21). Explain this principle in your own words. Where have you seen it play out in your own life?
4. **Read Matthew 6:22-23.** What difference does it make when you have a mindset of generosity toward your money and possessions? What makes this kind of perspective difficult to maintain?
5. **Read Matthew 6:24.** Jesus said we cannot serve both God and money. What are some warning signs that temporary possessions have become something we exist to serve?
6. Jesus doesn't just expose our divided hearts. He gave himself completely to save us. How does knowing what Jesus was willing to give for you change the way you view what you have?
7. Think of an area of your life where you've been doing the right things, but not in the right way. Since Jesus is your Master, what would it look like for him to change your "how" in that area this week?
