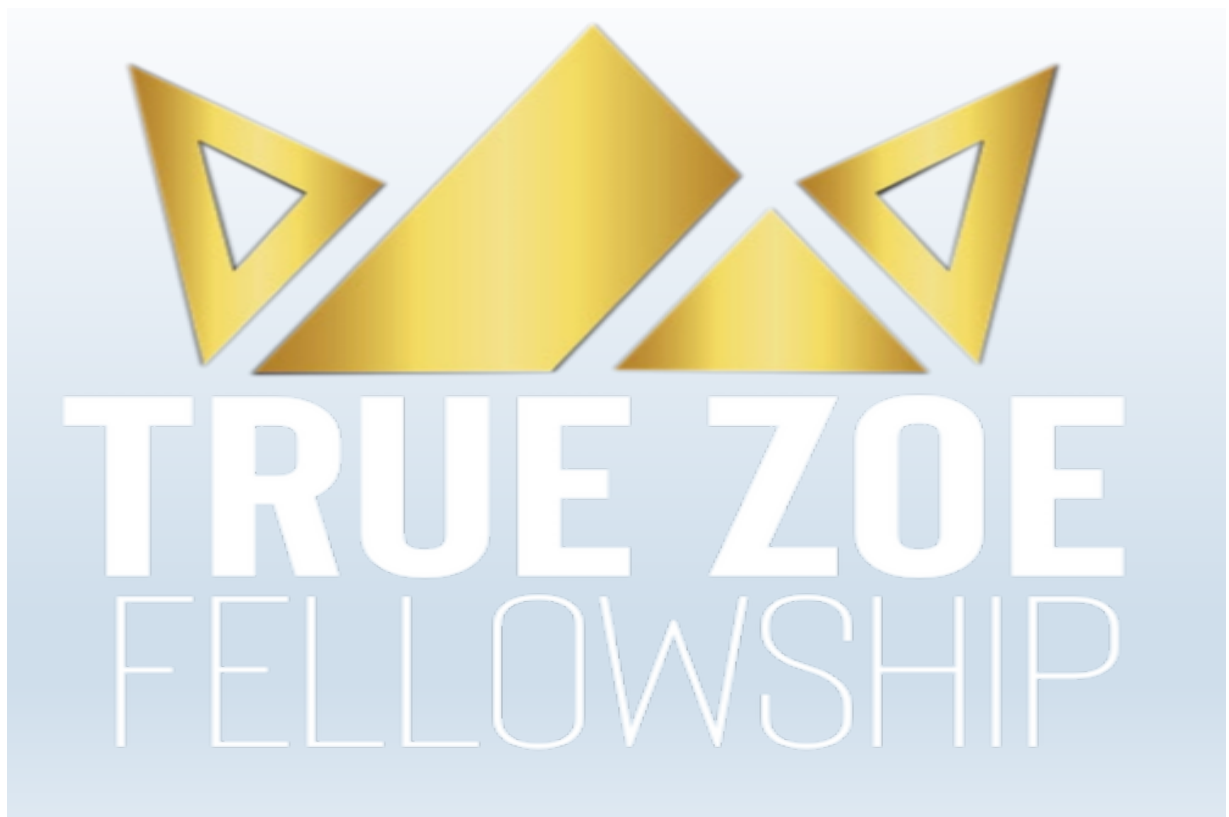




“Experiencing the Life God Intended”

CORE BELIEFS

The following are the core beliefs of True Zoe Fellowship based on the foundational truths taught in the bible. All of our teaching and ministry is rooted in and flows out of these biblical doctrines.

- God

There is one eternally existing God. He is the creator of all that exists, both visible and invisible, and is therefore worthy of all glory and praise. God is perfect in love, power, holiness, goodness, knowledge, wisdom, justice, and mercy. He is unchangeable and therefore is the same yesterday, today, and tomorrow.

There is one God, who has revealed Himself as our Father, in His Son Jesus Christ, and as the Holy Spirit. Jesus Christ is God manifested in flesh. He is both God and man. (*Deuteronomy 6:4; Ephesians 4:4-6; Colossians 2:9; 1 Timothy 3:16*)

- **The Kingdom of Heaven**

The Kingdom of Heaven (or Kingdom of God) is the spiritual and sovereign reign of God over creation, centered on the lordship of Jesus Christ rather than a physical location. It represents God's rule active in the present, transforming lives, and it will be fully realized upon Jesus' return.

- **The Bible**

The Bible is the infallible Word of God and the authority for salvation and Christian living (*// Timothy 3:16*). It is the word that contains spiritual intelligence, and through the word of God, we gain spiritual intelligence.

- **The Gospel**

The gospel, or "good news," is that Christ suffered the curse of sin once (and for all men), was buried, and rose again, providing deliverance and salvation to all who receive His redemptive and toning work by faith (*Romans 1:16,17; Acts 2:37*).

- **Salvation**

Salvation comes by grace through faith based on the atoning sacrifice of Jesus Christ. Jesus Christ came to reconcile humanity with God. The biblical foundation of salvation is having faith in the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus, repentance of sin, water baptism in the name of Jesus Christ as a show of allegiance, and receiving the gift of the Holy Spirit as the fulfillment of the new birth process in becoming a child of God. (*I Corinthians 15:1-4; Acts 2:4, 37-39; Romans 6:3-4*)

- **The Church**

The Church is the community of believers in Jesus Christ, rather than just a physical building. It represents a "powerful government" agency authorized by God to establish His kingdom rule on Earth. It serves as a local embassy representing heaven's interests, restoring humanity's citizenship through Christ. It is the agency through which God impacts earth with the culture of heaven.

- **The Spirit-led Life**

Jesus said, "I am the Vine, you are the branches. If you abide in me and I in you, you will bear much fruit; but apart from me you can do nothing." *John 15:5*. We believe the only way possible to live the Christian life is by God's power within us. We seek to practice daily dependence on God's Spirit to enable us to do what is right. (*Phil. 2:13, Eph. 5:18*)
