

Generate Camp Packing List

Bring:

- A positive attitude
- Pillow, Sleeping bag/Twin sheets, and/or blanket
- Bible, Notepad, Pen
- Athletic clothes for Games and recreation
- Closed-Toed/Close-Heeled Shoes
- Shower Shoes
- Refillable water bottle (with your name on it)
- Toiletry items (deodorant, toothbrush, soap, shampoo, etc.)
- Towels (one for the shower and one for other activities)
- Casual clothing for each day*
- Sunscreen
- Sun protection, hat, rain jacket
- Small Fan for room if needed
- Watch (not required, but will help with daily
- Bug Spray
- Money for souvenirs
- Medications - all medications need to be turned in to Pastor Nick before we leave for camp.
- Theme Items**
 - Your favorite superhero attire.
- Work gloves for our serve site

*Clothes and shoes may get dirty; please do not pack items that you are worried will get dirty

** Each camp has its own special theme for the week. These items will add to your overall camp experience but are not required.

DO NOT BRING:

- Clothing that is too tight
- Clothing that suggests inappropriate behavior
- Shirts that expose the midriff
- Skateboards, hoverboards, roller blades, etc.
