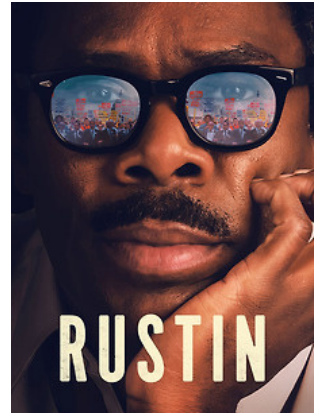


Father's Day Potluck — Today!
