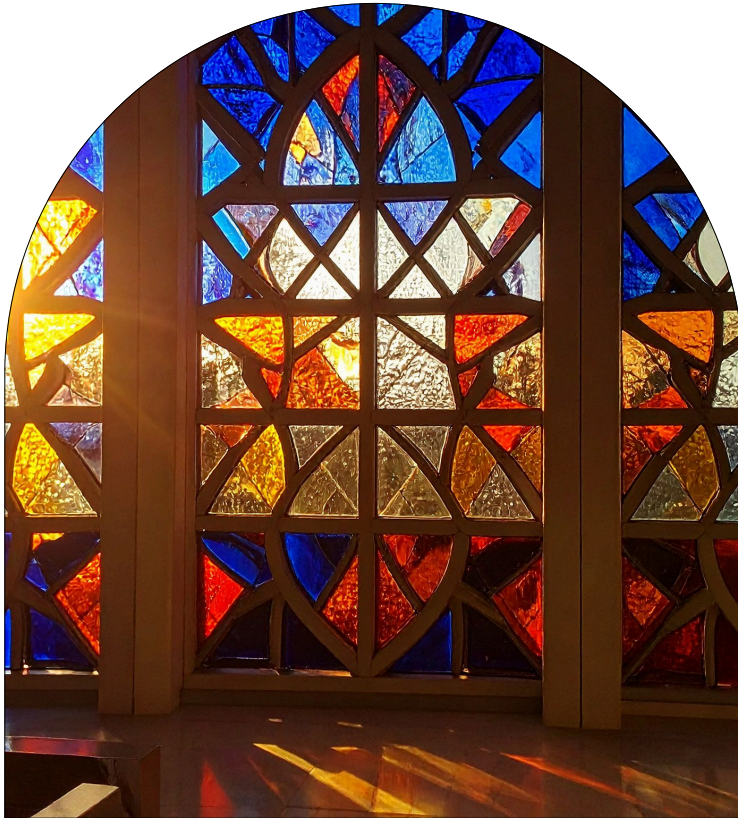

GETTING ACQUAINTED



Eleanor and Lee Posner

Eleanor was born in Indonesia and immigrated to the United States in 1982, settling in Glendale with her family. From the moment they arrived, they began attending Glendale City Church, a community she has remained devoted to ever since and where she looks forward to worshipping every Sabbath. After earning her R.N. license at Glendale Community College, she gained experience across a variety of facilities and hospitals, with a primary focus on visiting nursing, before her final staff position at Kaiser Sunset. Even while working full-time, she opened her own assisted living facility in North Hollywood, which she has continued to lead since 2001.

More than a decade ago, Eleanor expanded her reach to the Inland Empire, establishing a hospice business, a home health agency, and several congregate-style homes in Redlands that provide high-quality, 24-hour nursing care. She was the first to introduce this model to the region and is widely recognized as one of its leaders in the field. She has also founded Recoup Care to house homeless individuals, and — extending her compassion internationally — transformed her former home in Indonesia into an orphanage, to which she donates thousands of dollars each year.

Lee was born in Los Angeles and grew up in the West San Fernando Valley. He attended Pierce College before earning his B.A. from UCLA, where he became a passionate basketball fan during the final years of Coach Wooden's legendary tenure. He later earned his MBA from Pepperdine through night classes while working full-time. He built a career in accounting, with his final position as controller for a Burbank-based entertainment company specializing in film and tape storage for major studios, and is now retired.

Lee began attending Glendale City Church after marrying Eleanor in 1995, during the tenure of Pastor Mitch Henson, and officially joined the Adventist faith in 2012 when he was baptized by Pastor Rudy Torres. He currently serves as head of the church's Finance Committee and deeply values the congregation's welcoming and open spirit.

Their two daughters both graduated from Loma Linda University last year — Ellee earned her R.N. and now works alongside Eleanor, while Vivien Lee earned her M.D. and is currently completing her first year of residency at Loma Linda.
