

## SHOP & PREP



### WEEK 1

#### **ACTIVITY | Robotic Musical Chairs**

- WHAT TO GET:
  - o Printable
- WHAT TO PREP: Put up "Oil Cafe" sign in designated space.

#### **ACTIVITY | Loose Parts Robot Relay**

- WHAT TO GET:
  - o Printable (or large sheets of paper to draw your own robot outline)
  - Bottle caps
  - Old kevs
  - o Wire
  - o String
  - Cereal boxes
  - o Pasta
  - Various lids
  - o Pipe cleaners
  - o Buttons
  - o Plastic forks or spoons
  - o Tape or other starting line marker
  - Folding table or just place supplies on the floor
- WHAT TO PREP: Place all parts inside a chosen container, one per team. Print and assemble the robot outline from the printable provided or draw your own on a large piece of butcher paper.

- WHAT TO GET:
  - Suggested costume items for inventor:
    - Apron or lab coat
    - Safety goggles
    - Name tag
    - Scooter or hoverboard (optional)
  - o Suggested costume items for robot:
    - Aluminum foil
    - Cardboard boxes
    - Ducting vent hose
    - Wires
  - Suggested props:
    - Chalkboard or dry erase board
    - Computer monitors
    - Wires and mechanical parts
    - Gears
    - Tools
- WHAT TO PREP: Prepare props to set up your story space and costumes for an inventor and a robot. Or you can make a robot puppet instead.

# BIG IDEA | We change when we know who God is.

 WHAT TO PREP: GrowBot can be a freestanding robot built from cardboard tubes, boxes, and foil (something <u>like this</u>) or a more 2-D robot attached to the wall or a board (like this).

#### **ACTIVITY | Nuts and Bolts Snack**

- WHAT TO GET:
  - Marshmallows
  - Licorice
  - o Gumdrops
  - o Small chocolate candies
  - Pretzel sticks
  - o Foil plates (optional)
- WHAT TO PREP: As this is essentially a trail mix blend, check out <u>this image</u> for inspiration.

#### SCRIPTURE | Romans 12:1-3

 WHAT TO PREP: Prepare an image of a monarch butterfly (like <u>this one</u>) and a metamorphosis time-lapse video (like <u>this</u> <u>one</u>) to be shown.

# REFLECTION | How do we know we need to change?

 WHAT TO PREP: Have this <u>video</u> ready to play.

#### **RESPONSE** | Gears of Change

- WHAT TO GET:
  - o Printable
  - o Markers
  - Butcher paper
  - Long tables
  - o Twine
  - Tape
  - o Scissors
- WHAT TO PREP: Print and cut the printable so that each kid has one gear cutout, or you could have kids cut these out themselves. Line up two long tables and attach a roll of butcher paper below one end of the table by running a piece of twine through the tube and tying it to the table. Then, roll out the paper so that it covers the length of both tables to create the assembly line conveyor belt. Leave this out for the entire month as you will repeat this module every week. (If this is not possible, simply roll it up and bring it back out the following week.)

- WHAT TO PREP: Print out one copy of the printable and place it at a reasonable distance away from the group. Cover up each row of letters with painter's tape. You could also project it onto a screen.

#### **ACTIVITY | Rice Krispies Robot Snacks**

- WHAT TO GET:
  - o Rice Krispies Treats
  - o Edible googly eyes
  - Other candy pieces for robots

- WHAT TO GET:

- WHAT TO PREP: Use this song for some fun background music! Compile list of action words kids will act out, such as:

  - o Painting
  - o Climbing
  - o Surfing
  - o Skiina
  - o Doing a fun dance move kids know

- WHAT TO GET:
  - o Foil
  - o Painter's tape
  - o Other fun, random supplies
    - Cardboard boxes
    - Ducting vent hose
    - Wires
    - Paper plates, cups, or bowls
  - o Timer
- WHAT TO PREP: Pre-cut sheets of foil and fold them to distribute to kids (so that kids don't have to pull foil themselves and potentially get hurt.)

#### **RESPONSE | Gears of Change**

- WHAT TO GET:
  - o Printable
  - Markers
  - Butcher paper
  - Long tables
  - o Twine
  - o Tape
  - o Scissors
- WHAT TO PREP: If it was possible, the assembly line conveyor belt has been left up from Week 1. If not, simply unroll it and set it back up. Print and cut the printable so that each kid has one gear cutout, or you could have kids cut these out themselves.

#### **ACTIVITY | Rockin' Robot**

- A robot template like the one printed from this website or drawn yourself.
- String
- Stainless steel nuts (or pony beads)
- Tape
- Something to color with
- WHAT TO PREP: Pre-measure and cut all needed supplies to help move things along faster. Instructions for craft:
  - First, kids can color their robots with markers, crayons, or colored pencils.
     These can be pre-cut or cut out after the kids color them.
  - o Second, two 1.5 inch-cut straws can be taped onto the back of the robot.
  - Take a piece of <u>string</u>, four feet long, and thread both ends through the two straw pieces so that you form a giant loop above the robot.
  - Tie a <u>nut</u> (or a <u>pony bead</u>) onto each end of the string to keep the string from coming out of the straw pieces. Kids can hang the robot on a doorknob or from the ceiling. Grab one bead in each hand, pull out and away from the robot, and watch it come to life!
