WEEK 1

ACTIVITY | The Perfect Sidekick

- O blank paper
- O drawing utensils

ACTIVITY | Noodle Armor

- O pool noodles (at least 6-8 per team)
- O masking tape or strips of ribbons
 - WHAT TO PREP: Lay out piles of pool noodles at a station for each team. You might want to pre-cut some of the pool noodles into smaller segments horizontally, vertically, or even into curls to offer some creative size and shape options.

BIG IDEA | God prepares us to fight temptation.

- O cardboard or construction paper
- O paper
- O glue and/or tape
- O writing utensils
 - WHAT TO PREP: For a very simple, large book, staple a few large sheets of newspaper together and decorate it to look like a book, writing each of the Big Ideas on its own sheet. If you'd like to get a bit more whimsical, try this Book for Giants tutorial.

STORY | The Only Key

O *optional:* adventure-themed <u>background</u> <u>music</u>

OBJECT LESSON | Bible Barricade

- O Bibles
- O painter's tape or string

RESPONSE | Written on the Scroll

- O white paper
- O writing utensils
- O teabags soaking in warm water (enough for each kid to have one)
- O ribbon or fabric cut into strips, a minimum of 12 inches long
- O line or rack for drying
 - WHAT TO PREP: Check out this <u>tutorial</u> for directions on how to "age" paper for this activity.



ACTIVITY | Big Idea Bookmark

- O construction paper or cardstock
- O writing utensils
- O scissors
- O optional: string or yarn to make tassels
- O optional: hole punch
 - WHAT TO PREP: Before the kids arrive, cut out bookmark-sized rectangles in advance.

WEEK 2

ACTIVITY | Powerful Perspective

- O printable
 - WHAT TO PREP: Create a Powerpoint presentation or print images from printable.

ACTIVITY | Heavy Lifting

- O a set of sticks, <u>yardsticks</u>, empty wrapping paper tubes, or similar items(enough for multiple teams of four to six kids)
- O balloons
- O permanent marker
- O masking tape
 - WHAT TO PREP: Inflate balloons and attach them to both ends of the sticks (or similar items). Write "100 lbs" on them in permanent marker. Use masking tape to create two lines on the floor if your floor isn't marked.

OBJECT LESSON | A Fish in the Water

• WHAT TO PREP: Image from printable either printed or on Powerpoint.

RESPONSE | Invisible Powers

- O Cotton swabs
- O White paper
- O Whole milk
- O No. 2 pencils
- O Sandpaper

MEMORY VERSE | Break the Code

- O Paper
- O Pencils
 - WHAT TO PREP: Project or write out the memory verse, II Thessalonians 3:3 (NIV), for kids to look at while writing their codes.

ACTIVITY | True Equation

- O Paper
- O Writing utensils

WEEK 3

ACTIVITY Planet Green Light	REFLECTION Hands In The Dirt
O paper O drawing utensils	O pot or planter O bowl or bucket O potting soil
 ACTIVITY Special Seeds O plastic sandwich bags O paper towels O masking tape or stick-on labels O markers O seeds (preferably larger — sunflower and beans of any kind work well.) WHAT TO PREP: Place a damp paper towel in each bag for planting. 	 bulb (tulip, lily, or similar) moist towelettes or a handwashing station WHAT TO PREP: Fill the planter about halfway with potting soil and put anothe half pot full into a bowl or bucket so the kids can grab a pinch and sprinkle it. ACTIVITY | Birthday Every Day

- O printable
- O colorful cardstock paper
- O scissors
- O glue
 - WHAT TO PREP: Print the printable. Prepare a worked example of the pop-up card to show kids.

BIG IDEA | God celebrates us.

- O Big Idea storybook
- O dry erase board or large piece of paper
- O marker

OBJECT LESSON | Lost and Found

O a key (a standard key or you can create a giant, glittery cardboard key)

ACTIVITY | Otherworldly Party Hats

- O colored construction paper
- O markers
- O glue
- O decorating materials (i.e., stickers, sequins, feathers, buttons, beads, foam pieces, etc.)
 - WHAT TO PREP: You can pre-make the hats by shaping the construction paper into cones to save time.

ACTIVITY | Flip 'N Restore

- O small pads of sticky notes (one per kid)
- O writing utensils

- O sticky notes
- O writing and drawing utensils
