



Getting More from the Message – John 11:28-37

Community Group Questions – Week of April 26th, 2026

Getting Started: Read this week's passage out loud & pray the Holy Spirit will help you understand.

Ice Breaker: What are some of the different ways people react to death?

1) Why is it important for a follower of Jesus to spend time with the Lord when they lose someone close to them? Have you ever seen someone fall away from the faith when they lost someone?

2) Why do you think that sometimes Jesus will call us to deeper faith in difficult times?

3) How can we balance serving Jesus, sitting at His feet, and all of the aspects of American life?

4) How do we as a church sit at the feet of Jesus every Sunday?

5) In this chapter, we see that suffering comes to all people, including believers. Why is trusting in God's timing so important?

6) Jesus said His "yoke is easy." Yet life can be so hard! How can we think about that?

7) Read verse 37 out loud. Why is it important to understand that some (often many) of the things some people say in the Bible are not correct? (Not Jesus, of course!)

8) Why is it important that we accept that God has a plan, even if we can't see it? (And we may not until the next life)

9) Was there anything you wanted to ask or say to the group this week?

10) Was there anything specific you think God wanted you to take away or change from this passage?

11) How can we pray for you in regard to what we studied this week? Other prayer requests are fine, but we are also looking for a specific prayer for you regarding this week's passage.
