Community Group Questions – Week of March 15th, 2026

Getting Started: Read this week's passage out loud & pray the Holy Spirit will help you understand.

Ice Breaker: How would you respond to someone who said their sin is too great for God to forgive?

- 1) How would you respond to the lies in your head that your sin is too great for God to forgive?

- 2) What is the danger of trying to associate your faith with what you do, compared to what Jesus has done for you? (Do you ever think that way, or have you in the past?)

- 3) When we read about the miracles of Jesus, do you think we should pause and think about them? Why or why not? (How might it be helpful if we did?)

- 4) Why did Jesus **not** avoid the Cross? Answer for the world, the church, and for you personally.

- 5) Why do you think the scripture is often so critical of some church leadership? (see James 3:1)

- 6) Read John 20:30-31. What do these words tell us about the Bible and our proper use of it in sharing faith?

- 7) How did the verse about the centurion and those with him affect you? Did they in any way convince you that some of the people we know who don't believe might be worth an extra effort?

- 8) Was there anything you wanted to ask or say to the group this week?

- 9) Was there anything specific you think God wanted you to take away or change from this passage?

- 10) How can we pray for you in regard to what we studied this week? Other prayer requests are fine, but we are also looking for a specific prayer for you regarding this week's passage.
