UF ATHLETIC MINISTRIES
Athletic Ministries is a unique way for College First to reach out and engage with student athletes at the University of Findlay. This program allows college athletic teams to connect with a College First pastor or leader in order to have meaningful devotions and create connections with student athletes, and even their coaches. Currently, Pastor Nancy Hiser serves as the chaplain for the volleyball team, Pastor Lance Finley serves with the football team, Pastor Kimberly Reese serves with the cross country and long distance running teams and Pastor Kirk Schneemann serves with the basketball team. Though the specifics of each person’s chaplaincy role is a bit different from team to team, each athletic organization spends time hearing a devotion with biblical truth and everyday application. These devotions with student athletes plant a seed for them to learn more about God or explore their existing faith further. Athletics Ministries is a way to blend both the Word and the excitement of sports in a way that can better help the athletes connect with God and serve him through their play either on the court or the field.

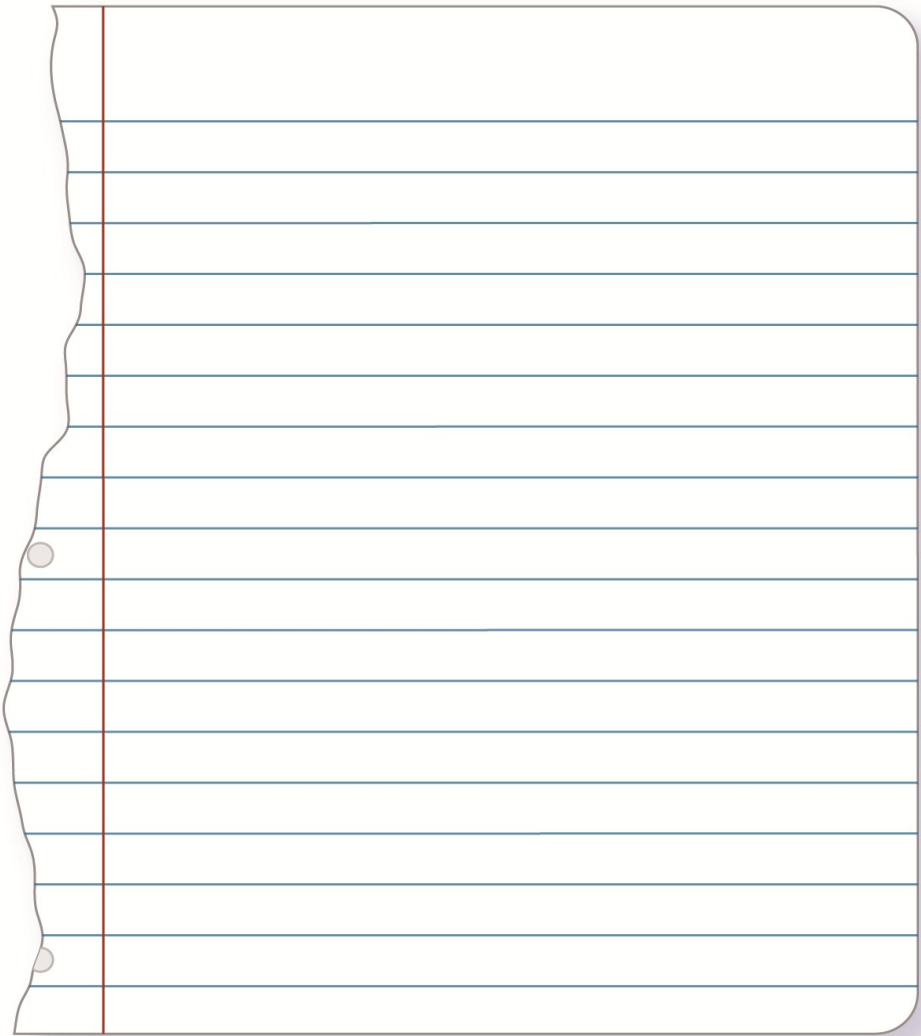
