MEN'S MINISTRY BIBLE STUDY

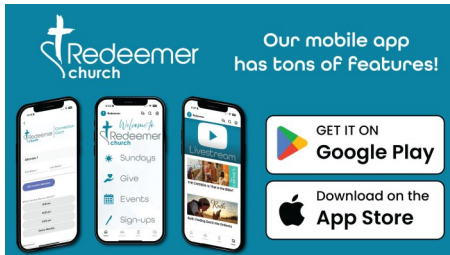
Come join us!

GETTING STARTED

What is the longest car trip you can remember taking with family? Where did you go & why?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. What do you find striking about God's call and promise to Abram in Genesis 12:1-3?
2. What do you think was the main reason Abram was willing to pick up and take off into the unknown?
3. How is Abram's response an example of faith? (v.4-8)
4. God called Abram to step out into the unknown. Where is God currently calling you to trust him with something uncertain or uncomfortable?
5. What helps you hold on to God's promises when circumstances make them hard to believe?
6. How do the accounts of Abraham, Isaac, Jacob, and Joseph help us to understand God's plans for our world?
7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord God, thank you for your call to Abram and his family so long ago. Thank you that they followed you in faith. Help us to trust where we can't see and to depend upon your faithfulness. May we step out and watch you work in us and through us to be a blessing to those around us. In the name of Jesus, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Genesis 12:1-8 and 15:1-7. Why does God repeat the covenant promise to Abram in chapter 15? What has or has not changed? How have you learned to hear God's call on your life? Think about a time when you stepped out in faith. How did God provide for you? What did you learn during that time?
