GETTING STARTED

What are you looking forward to the most this week?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Read Psalm 23:6 in both versions below. What nuances do you see in each translation? How does it relate to your understanding?
2. How does "goodness" differ from "mercy?" How are they the same?
3. Where in your life do you most need God's goodness and mercy right now?
4. Do you feel "homesick" for heaven? Explain. How does your body remind you that this is not your forever home?
5. What most convinces you that God can be trusted to lead you home?
6. What have you learned from this Psalm 23 series over the last five weeks? What will you take with you? What "bags" do you need to set down this summer?
7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord God, thank you for this beautiful psalm that gives us a picture of your constant care and provision for us. Remind us that earth is not our forever home; we are here only for a little while. May we always trust that your goodness and mercy will lead us safely home. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Psalm 23:1-6. What metaphors of the sheep and shepherd mean the most to you? Focus on the last word of the psalm: "forever." How is this a fitting conclusion to what David wrote? Do a study of the four Gospels and the book of Acts on the Lord Jesus' resurrection body. Describe it. Then realize that our resurrection bodies will look and act similar to his!
