

BIG IDEA | **IF THERE WAS GRACE FOR PETER, THERE IS GRACE FOR YOU**

“So they arrested him and led him to the high priest’s home. And Peter followed at a distance. The guards lit a fire in the middle of the courtyard and sat around it, and Peter joined them there. A servant girl noticed him in the firelight and began staring at him. Finally she said, ‘This man was one of Jesus’ followers!’ But Peter denied it. ‘Woman,’ he said, ‘I don’t even know him!’ After a while someone else looked at him and said, ‘You must be one of them!’ ‘No, man, I’m not!’ Peter retorted. About an hour later someone else insisted... While he was still speaking, the rooster crowed.”
Luke 22:54-60

GETTING STARTED

When in your life were you most disappointed with yourself ?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Given Peter’s bold declaration in vs.33, what accounts for Peter’s actions now? Why did Peter deny he knew Jesus ?
2. How were the three denials similar? Different? Do you think he realized what he was doing? Why or why not?
3. How do imagine Peter felt when the rooster crowed and Jesus looked at him?
4. When have you, perhaps, felt like Peter? How have you felt the bitterness of blowing it in something related to your faith?
5. How does Peter’s story here both humble and encourage you?
6. When have you felt the grace of Jesus in a broken moment? How has it changed you?
7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, thank you for caring for us and forgiving us when we fail to stand up for you. In the moments when we disappoint you or disappoint ourselves, help us to continue to lean into you and not run away. May we feel your forgiveness and grace in our worst times. Thank you that your love never changes. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Luke 22:54-62, Mt. 26:69-75, Mark 14:66-72 and John 18:16-18,25-27. What do you see in these four accounts of Peter’s denial? What do you suppose Peter did after leaving the courtyard in the middle of the night? What have you found helpful in dealing with failure? How do you explain the ups and downs in your own spiritual life?
