BIG IDEA | **NO MATTER WHAT, JESUS IS YOUR ADVOCATE**

“Simon, Simon, Satan has asked to sift each of you like wheat. But I have pleaded in prayer for you, Simon, that your faith should not fail. So when you have repented and turned to me again, strengthen your brothers.’ Peter said, ‘Lord, I am ready to go to prison with you, and even to die with you.’ But Jesus said, ‘Peter, let me tell you something. Before the rooster crows tomorrow morning, you will deny three times that you even know me.’ Then Jesus asked them, ‘When I sent you out to preach the Good News and you did not have money...did you need anything?’ “No,” they replied.”
Luke 22:31-35

GETTING STARTED

Who is someone you admire because he/she made a comeback after a defeat or injury?

REFLECTION/DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. How must Peter have felt in vs. 31-34?
2. What are the differences between Judas (v.1-6) and Peter, since both failed Jesus?
3. What is Jesus trying to impress upon Peter and the others in vs. 35-38?
4. Share about a time when you over-promised something and couldn't deliver it. What happened? How did you feel?
5. Where might you see yourself in this conversation between Peter and Jesus? When have you been “over-confident” in your faith or relationship with Christ?
6. How can you depend upon Jesus as your Advocate, knowing he continually prays for you, even when you wander away, disappoint him or even fail him?
7. What are the prayer requests on your mind and heart today?

PRAYER: Lord Jesus, thank you for your unconditional love, even when we over-promise and under deliver. In addition to dying for us, you also live to make intercession and pray for us. You know our past and our future. May we learn from Peter's interaction with you and know that we can always get back on track with you. Thank you for this incredible gift. In the name of Christ, we pray, Amen.

GOING DEEPER: Read Luke 22:31-38, Matthew 26:31-35, Mark 14:27-31, and John 13:37-38. The prediction of Peter's denial is found in all four gospel accounts. How would you have responded if your huge failure was recorded for centuries to study? What character qualities do we see in Peter? What do we learn about Jesus here? How can you learn from past mistakes?
