3. Why do you think Caleb wanted the very area where the Anakim giants lived? How does faith enable a person to confront giants instead of avoiding them?
4. What is the difference between asking God to bless our ideas and asking Him to fulfill His word?
5. How do you think Caleb endured such a long delay of 45 years without losing devotion to the Lord? What do you think kept him from becoming bitter during the long delay?
6. Which application point resonated most with you, and why?
