1. What stands out most to you in 1 Peter 3:15, “In your hearts, honor Christ as Lord. Always be prepared to give an answer to everyone who asks you to give the reason for the hope that is in you, but do this with gentleness and respect”?
2. Why do you think Peter begins with “in your hearts, honor Christ as Lord” before talking about giving answers?
3. How can apologetics become unhealthy when it is disconnected from worship and surrender?
4. What is the difference between winning an argument and giving a faithful witness?
5. Why is it important that Peter says to give a reason for the hope within us, not just a defense of our beliefs?
6. Have you ever seen someone defend Christianity in a way that lacked gentleness and respect? What effect did it have?
7. What fears keep many Christians from answering hard questions about their faith?
8. What does it look like in everyday life to be “ready to give a reason”?
9. How would you explain to someone that faith and reason are not enemies?
10. Why can’t even the best arguments save someone apart from the Holy Spirit?
11. The presentation says science can explain mechanisms, but not fully answer meaning and purpose questions. How would you explain that to someone else?
