Galatians 3 “Miracles” Reflection Questions 06/07/2026

1. What does Galatians 3:5 teach us about the relationship between faith, the Holy Spirit, and miracles?
2. What do you think it means to “fully preach the gospel,” as Paul describes in Romans 15:18–19?
3. What could happen if a church emphasizes biblical teaching but has no expectation of the Spirit’s power?
4. What could happen if a church emphasizes supernatural experiences but neglects Biblical truth?
5. What fears or concerns might prevent Christians from praying for healing or supernatural intervention?
6. How should Christians remain open to miracles without becoming gullible or accepting every supernatural claim?
7. What safeguards can a church use to avoid manipulation, exaggeration, or false reports of miracles?
8. How should we respond when we pray for a miracle and do not see the outcome we hoped for?
9. What is a worldview, and how does it influence the way we interpret our experiences?
10. What assumptions about reality have you likely absorbed from Western culture?
11. What are the strengths and weaknesses of both rational knowledge and experiential knowledge?
12. What does Daniel 10:7 and John 12:29 teach us about how different people may experience the same spiritual event differently?
13. Discuss this statement: “A person can experience something miraculous and still interpret it in a way that protects the worldview they already hold.”
14. In Acts 28, how did the native islanders, a modern rationalist, and the apostle Paul each interpret the venomous snakebite differently?
