Parable of the Growing Seed Reflection Questions 09/20/2026

1. Why do you think Jesus compared God's kingdom to a seed rather than something immediately powerful or impressive?
2. According to this parable, what is the farmer's responsibility, and what belongs to God alone?
3. What "seed" might God be asking you to sow faithfully in this season of your life?
4. If visible growth results do not always determine faithfulness, how should we evaluate whether we are being faithful?
5. Who sowed seeds of faith into your life—perhaps without ever seeing the eventual outcome?
6. What does the farmer's ability to sleep teach us about trusting God and accepting our limitations?
7. Where have you mistaken the absence of visible progress for the absence of God's activity?
8. How can we create conditions that encourage spiritual growth without trying to manipulate or force it?
9. Where might you need to recognize and celebrate "stalk-stage" growth, either in yourself or someone else?
10. What can happen when we demand "harvest-stage" maturity from someone who is still early in the process?
11. How can we give people grace and time to grow without lowering God's call toward maturity?
12. Is God asking you to keep waiting faithfully, or has something become "ripe" and now requires action?
