Parable of the Two Builders Reflection Questions 09/27/2026

1. The sermon said we are all building something through our daily choices. What are you investing the most time and energy in right now?
2. What are some “counterfeit blueprints” that compete with Jesus’ wisdom in our culture or in your own thinking?
3. What does it mean in everyday life to build on Christ as your foundation?
4. The sermon spoke about finding our identity, purpose, and confidence in Christ. Which of those is hardest for you to rest in?
5. Both houses in the parable faced a flood. What does that tell us about following Jesus through difficult seasons?
6. What is the difference between knowing a great deal **about** God and growing in trust **with** Him?
7. The sermon connected wise building with using materials that last. What choices or habits in your life are taking time and effort but producing lasting fruit?
8. The sermon compared God’s work in us to a building inspection. Why might we resist letting Him reveal a weakness beneath the surface?
9. Read Psalm 139:23–24. Is there an area of your life where you would like to invite God to “search” and lead you?
10. In the sermon, the speaker shared that she first tried to solve her anxiety on her own. When have you found yourself rushing to fix something before listening to God?
11. What might it look like for you to “dig deep” with the Lord in this season? What is one practical step you could take this week?
12. How does the promise of Philippians 1:6—that God will complete the good work he began—change the way you respond when he shows you an area where you need to grow?
