I (Cristian) recently had the opportunity to travel to Chile to help complete the recording of the *Jesus Film*, *Mary Magdalene*, and *Story of Jesus* for Children in Mapundungun. I was reminded the films are only the beginning. The goal is to place this gospel tool into hands of believers that can take them to their own communities. For many Mapuche communities, spiritual traditions are deeply woven into everyday life. Spiritism, witchcraft, and the worship of false gods are practiced by many. Please read my newsletter for an encouraging story of one such woman and how everything changed when she encountered Jesus. What a wonderful journey to remind us that the gospel doesn't erase our history, it transforms it. Christ takes what was once broken and uses it for His glory.
