Silas' school has been a big win for our family – kids at his church also attend his school (a rarity living in Utah), and he seems to have jumped right in, though with the normal fatigue of being in a cross-cultural setting all day. All three older kids have started tennis once a week, which is an answer to prayer and continues a hobby we started in the states. Please pray that we'd find other outlets for them, particularly an affordable music teacher.
