MATTHEW 6:25-34

### No worries about the future

In Matthew 6:25–34, Jesus speaks directly to one of the most common struggles we face—worry. He addresses the everyday concerns that can easily consume our thoughts: what we will eat, what we will wear, how things will work out. Rather than dismissing these concerns, Jesus gently reframes them, pointing us to a deeper truth about who God is. He uses simple but powerful images—birds of the air and flowers of the field—to remind us that God is both aware of and actively caring for His creation. If God provides so faithfully for them, how much more will He care for us? At the heart of this passage is not just a call to stop worrying, but an invitation to trust. Jesus shifts our focus from anxiety about tomorrow to faith in God's provision today. He calls us to “seek first the kingdom of God,” prioritizing our relationship with Him above everything else, trusting that our needs will be met along the way.
