FROM THE PASTOR

MOTHER'S DAY

Happy Mother's Day to all of our mothers, grandmothers, foster mothers, stepmothers, and all women who play any kind of maternal role in someone's life. And we offer our prayers and congratulations to all expectant mothers, as they await the birth of their child.

We all know how important mothers are. Their womb is the pathway by which we enter into this world. They nurse us, feed us, clean us, clothe us, protect us, teach and form us, and in so many different ways, they love us. Fathers play an important role as well, but that is for a different holiday.

As we celebrate Mother's Day, as we do on Mother's Day, we honor the family, the most significant institution in our human world. God Himself created the family, in an imitation of Himself, who is a family – the Holy Trinity. There is a saying that, "As goes the family, so goes the society. As goes the family, so goes the Church." The family is the basic unit of society and the Church. It is no accident that the breakdown of the family in our modern times has led to a breakdown of society and the Church.

At the heart of the family is the mother. Along with fathers, mothers build up and give stability to the family. In many ways, her love is the core of the household and the glue that holds it all together.

We know that all of our mothers are not perfect. In fact, none of them are. And we know that many mothers (and fathers) are unfortunately wounded by life and fail in some ways to give their children the love that they need. Today, as we pray for all Moms, we need to pray for these women who have been wounded and damaged by their own family lives, and who struggle to make good decisions, to care for and provide for their children. The vast majority are doing the best that they possibly can.

Let us pray today for all of our mothers, living and deceased, and ask God's blessing upon them all, especially those who are struggling, hurting, and feel lost and afraid.

From the Cross, Jesus looked down at His Mother and the Beloved Disciple. He said to them, "Woman, behold your son. Son, behold your Mother." In this act, Jesus not only gave Mary to be the mother of John, but all of us. We call upon her, and we honor her, too, on this beautiful day.

THE PROMISE OF THE SPIRIT

Before He died, Jesus gave His disciples the promise of the Holy Spirit, which would be fulfilled on Pentecost Sunday. He described the Spirit as "another Advocate." The word "advocate" is one that refers to a defense attorney who would stand by us when we are on trial, guiding us, defending us, assisting us, and supporting us. The Spirit is the Spirit of Jesus, living in us, and is the presence of Christ in our world. The Greek word translated as Advocate is Paraclete, one of the great titles given to the Spirit.

Preparing the Apostles for His coming death, He says, "I will not leave you orphans." At His Ascension, they would feel like orphans, cast out into the world too soon, too early to take care of themselves, and to fulfill the great mission with which they were being entrusted. They feared the coming grief, but also the sense of being too small and insignificant to do what needed to be done. Jesus is assuring them that they will not be alone and would be given what they would need.

He also referred to the Spirit of Truth. In another passage, He speaks of this Spirit of Truth, who would lead His Church into all truth. They will need that Spirit of Truth as they face new and unexpected situations and questions that Jesus had not spoken about to them.

THE ASCENSION OF THE LORD

The Ascension of the Lord took place fifty days after Jesus rose from the dead. If we celebrated it on that fiftieth day of Easter, we would do so this Thursday, May 14. A number of years ago, the Bishops of the United States transferred the celebration of that feast to the following Sunday, making it easier for the people to make it to Mass on that day.

Therefore, next Sunday will be the celebration of the Ascension of the Lord.

OUR LADY OF FATIMA

On May 13, 1917, the Blessed Mother began appearing monthly to three Portuguese children in the village of Fatima. These would continue until October 13 of that same year. Her message throughout was a call to prayer, as an answer to many of our personal struggles, and as a way for the Peace of Christ to bring an end to World War I, to avoid World War II, and the destruction of the Cold War. As so few took up Mary's challenge, peace has continued to be elusive, although many believe that the destruction has been minimized.

In her messages to the children, she gave them three secrets. The first was revealed as a call to honor her Immaculate Heart. The second was a vision into Hell. The third was kept secret until Pope John Paul II ordered it to be addressed in the year 2000, with a document explaining its meaning. In that document, he expressed his belief that it was foretelling the assassination attempt on his life on May 13, 1981.

The message of the Secrets is a call to prayer. Unfortunately, many Catholic conspiracy theorists have hijacked the messages, to put forth their own distorted explanations.

In every apparition of Our Lady, she has given forth the same message, "Pray! Pray! Pray!" May we honor her request. This Wednesday, May 13, is the Feast of Our Lady of Fatima.


