



Sick Child Policy

In order to provide a safe, healthy place for all our children, we ask that you keep your child home any time he or she exhibits any of the following symptoms:

- Fever within the previous 24 hours
- Vomiting and/or diarrhea within the previous 24 hours
- Any symptoms of childhood diseases (scarlet fever, measles, mumps, chicken pox, whooping cough, etc.)
- Runny nose with any colored discharge
- Excessive coughing
- Sore throat
- Any unexplained rash
- Pink eye
- Head lice (child should be free of all nits)

If your child is being treated with an antibiotic, he or she should have received treatment for at least 24 hours before coming to the B.U.G.S. or Calvary Kids rooms.

For protection of all the children and our caregivers, follow these guidelines when admitting children to the B.U.G.S. and Calvary Kids rooms.
