Youth Code of Conduct

At Uttermost Youth, we believe every young person is called to represent Jesus in the way they speak, act, and treat others. Our desire is to create a safe, fun, and Christ-centered environment where everyone can grow in their faith and enjoy the retreat together.

Love God and Respect Others

- Treat every person with kindness, respect, and compassion.
- Encourage one another and help create a welcoming environment.
- Bullying, gossip, harassment, intimidation, or discrimination will not be tolerated.
- Honor leaders, volunteers, chaperones, retreat staff, and fellow youth.

Christ-Like Behavior

- Use language that honors God.
- Participate fully in worship, Bible teaching, small groups, and activities.
- Choose attitudes and actions that build others up.
- Live in a way that reflects Jesus.

Respect for Property

- Respect the retreat home, church vehicles, equipment, and personal belongings.
- Clean up after yourself.
- Parents/guardians may be responsible for intentional damage.

Safety

- Remain with the group unless given permission by a leader.
- Follow leader instructions promptly.
- Report injuries, illness, or unsafe situations immediately.

Electronics Policy

- Cell phones are permitted but should not distract from worship, Bible study, or activities.
- Photography and videos should respect the privacy of others.
- Leaders may temporarily collect devices if they become a distraction.

Dress Code

- Dress modestly and appropriately for a Christian retreat.
- Avoid clothing with offensive language, inappropriate graphics, or messages contrary to Christian values.
- Wear modest swimwear if swimming is part of the retreat.

Prohibited Items

- No alcohol, tobacco, vaping products, illegal drugs, weapons, fireworks, or other inappropriate materials.

Relationships

- Honor one another with purity and respect.
- Public displays of affection are not appropriate during the retreat.
- Respect personal boundaries.

Consequences

- Our desire is always restoration, not punishment.
- Repeated or serious misconduct may result in parent notification, or being sent home at the parent's expense.
