Title: Wake Up and Walk in Love

Text: Romans 13:8–14



Know It

Read Romans 13:8–14 aloud

Love Is a Lifelong Debt (v. 8–10)

Key idea: Love is not optional—it’s ongoing.

Discuss:

1. Paul says we “owe” love—what does that mean practically?
2. Why do you think love “fulfills the law” instead of replacing it?
3. Which is harder for you:
 - Avoiding sinful actions?
 - Or actively loving people well?

Go deeper:

- Where is it hardest for you to show consistent love right now? (home, work, church, etc.)

Truth to emphasize:

👉 Love is not just what you feel—it’s how you choose to act toward others.

Wake Up and Put On Christ (v. 11–14)

Key idea: The Christian life requires urgency and intentionality.

Discuss:

1. What does “spiritual sleep” look like in real life?
2. Why do you think Paul connects urgency with holiness?
3. What are some “works of darkness” that people often tolerate today?

Go deeper:

- What does it practically mean to “put on Christ” in your daily life?
- What are some ways we “make provision for the flesh” without realizing it?

Personal reflection:

👉 What is one area where you need to “wake up” spiritually?

Live It

Application Question:

- What is ONE action step you will take this week based on this passage?
(Examples: reconcile with someone, remove a temptation, be intentional in love)



Prayer

Close in prayer:

- Ask God to help you love consistently
- Ask for awareness and urgency spiritually
- Ask for strength to “put on Christ”
