

# OAY COVENANT

Honoring God in all that we do

## 1. WE PUT GOD FIRST IN EVERYTHING.

- a. This includes how we speak, what we listen to, what we watch, and how we spend time together.

## 2. WE REPRESENT JESUS WITH OUR ACTIONS AND ATTITUDES.

- a. This includes respecting authority, modeling honesty, kindness, humility, grace, compassion, and generally creating a safe space.

## 3. WE HONOR GOD WITH OUR BODIES.

- a. This includes rejecting drugs, alcohol, and tobacco; anything that harms or controls us.
- b. This also includes rejecting inappropriate physical contact.

## 4. WE CHOOSE PURITY IN WHAT WE WEAR AND HOW WE PRESENT OURSELVES.

- a. This includes how we behave and the dress code on page 2.

## 5. WE TREAT OTHERS WITH RESPECT AND LOVE.

- a. This includes refusing to bully, fight, or tear others down — in person or online.  
*Pranking will get you sent home if I don't think it's in good taste.*

## 6. WE CREATE A SAFE AND TRUSTWORTHY ENVIRONMENT.

- a. This includes having no weapons or dangerous items and reckless behavior.

## 7. WE FOLLOW LEADERSHIP AND RESPECT AUTHORITY.

- a. This includes trusting, listening to, and obeying the leaders placed over us for our good.

## 8. WE CHOOSE HONESTY AND INTEGRITY.

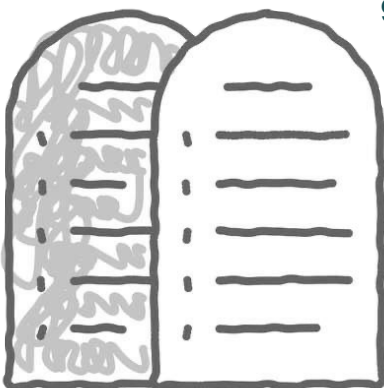
- a. This includes a refusal to lie, leave out the truth, sneak, or hide things that break trust.

- a. This includes reject drama, gossip, jealousy, selfishness, and any other actions that pulls away from Jesus.
