Memory Verse

"Put God's kingdom first." • Matthew 6:33 NIV

Free Play

- Welcome children as they arrive and help guide them to a play station.
- Spread out among the play stations.
- Encourage 3-4 children at each station.
- Engage with children through play and conversation.
- Help children share, take turns, and include others.
- If a child stays at one station for a long time, gently encourage them to explore another station.
- Watch for children who are alone and help them join a group.

Kingdom Parade

How to Play:

Children run to the leader, who gives them a high-five!

Leader Says:

"God loves us and wants us in His family!"

What You Do:

- Give each child a **Kingdom Castle** outline and crayons.
- Encourage the children to color their castle.
- Help the children tape the flags to the tops of the castle towers.
- Invite them to glue the windows and door onto the castle.
- Have the children glue cotton balls in the sky to make fluffy clouds.
- Finally, ask the children to glue the flowers at the bottom of the castle.

What You Say:

"Jesus used parables to teach us about God's kingdom. All summer long, we've been learning about God's kingdom through the stories Jesus told. Today, we're going to celebrate everything we've learned by making our very own Kingdom Castle!"

What You Need

- Crown (1 per child)
- Streamer (1 per child)

What You Say

"Today we're going to celebrate God's kingdom! Everyone put on your crown and pick up a streamer. Let's march together and celebrate all that we've learned about God's kingdom this summer!"

Leader Cheers (repeat as the children march):

- **"Jesus teaches me about God's kingdom!"**
- **"God's kingdom is growing!"**
- **"Hooray for Jesus!"**
- **"Jesus is our King!"** (optional)
- **"God's kingdom is the greatest treasure!"** (optional)

Snack Time

Home Time

Play upbeat worship music as the children march around the room, waving their streamers and celebrating together. This makes for a fun, joyful ending to your **Kingdom Quest** summer series.

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- Say grace before serving the snack.
 - Check for allergies on each child's name tag or attendance sheet before serving.
 - Serve 1–2 cookies per child.
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- Ensure each kid's name tag matches the parent's pick-up tag at dismissal.
- Clean the room after all kids have been dismissed.
