"May your kingdom come. May what you want to happen be done on earth as it is done in heaven" - Matthew 6:10

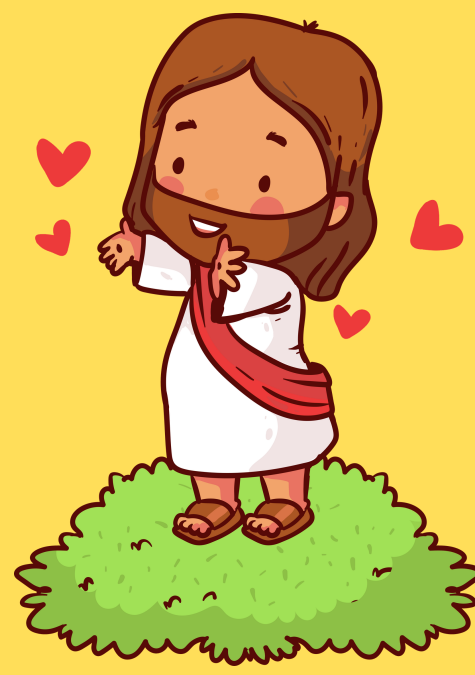


CRAFT: The hidden Treasure

WHAT YOU SAY:

"As you work on your 'Hidden Treasure' craft, let's think about a story Jesus told. In this story, a man found a pearl so incredible that he knew it was the most valuable thing in the entire world. But here's the secret, God and His kingdom are even more valuable than that! They are worth more than anything else we could ever find. When Jesus first called His disciples, they already seemed to get it. Peter and Andrew were out fishing on the Sea of Galilee when Jesus walked up and said: 'Come and follow me. ... I will send you out to fish for people.' (Matthew 4:19) Right after that, Jesus called James and John straight out of their fishing boat too. And do you know what all four of them did? They dropped their nets immediately! They left their boats, their jobs, and their ordinary lives behind to follow Him. Even if they didn't understand everything yet, their hearts knew one big thing and that was that Jesus is worth everything. They traded their old lives to help spread the great news of God's kingdom. God's kingdom is the most incredible, valuable treasure ever, and Jesus wants all of us to know that loving God and His kingdom is most important!"

Here is what you
need:

Glue the shell
cutout to the
outside of the
plate.

3



Decorate the outside with
animal cutouts.

4



Glue the Bottom Line to
the inside of the plate (just
like in the picture).

5



Decorate the inside with gem stickers.

6



Add gem stickers to the outside (as shown in the picture).

7



Stick the fish stickers to the inside of the plate.

8



Attach the pearl using double-sided tape (as shown in the picture).

9



It should look like this.

Fold the plate in half as it shows in the picture.

11



This is what your shell plate should look like from the outside!
