What You Need

No supplies needed

- Welcome children as they arrive and help guide them to a play station.
- Spread out among the play stations.
- Encourage 3–4 children at each station.
- Engage with children through play and conversation.
- Help children share, take turns, and include others.
- If a child stays at one station for a long time, gently encourage them to explore another station.
- Watch for children who are alone and help them join a group.

What You Say:

AMAZING MUSIC

WORSHIP LEADER: "Now, let's worship our big, strong God because He is super wonderful. Sing with me!"

SONG: "Super Wonderful"

"Great singing, friends! God gave us Jesus, and those are words that Jesus said. Jesus was saying that He wanted whatever God wants. Jesus always wants to go God's way, and when we follow Jesus, that's where He's going to lead us. Let's sing!"

SONG: "Roll with You"

"Thanks for worshipping with me!"

Please invite the children to come to the carpet area and help them settle down. Encourage them to listen carefully and engage with the Bible story.

Prayer

What You Need

No supplies needed

"Your kingdom come (*point up*) your will be done, (*hold hands out, palms up*) on earth (*point down*) as it is in heaven" (*point up*) Matthew 6:10 NIV. (*Open hands like a book.*)

"Can you do that with me?"

(Lead children to say the Memory Verse with Hand Motions once or twice.)

"Great job, friends!"

What You Do:

- Give each child a party hat, sparkly stickers, and bright-colored tissue paper cutouts.
- Encourage the kids to decorate their hats with the sparkly stickers.
- Ask the kids to crumble the tissue paper and glue it onto their party hats.
- Help them add the Bottom Line sticker to their hats.

What You Say:

The father of the lost son was so happy that his son came home that he threw a big celebration. In the same way, God celebrates every person who becomes part of His kingdom. God loves us so much and wants all of us to be with Him forever.

Ask the kids to wear the party hats they made, and then give each child a party horn.

Say: "Let's have a celebration parade and celebrate God's love together!"

"Dear God, thank You so much for loving us. You love everyone, not just a few people. Help us to love and celebrate people the way You love them, so we can all be a part of Your kingdom. We pray in Jesus' name. Amen."

Snack Time

- Say grace before serving the snack.
 - Check for allergies on each child's name tag or attendance sheet before serving.
 - Serve 1-2 cookies per child.
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Free Play

- Kids may play at the stations until they are picked up.
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Home Time

- Ensure each kid's name tag matches the parent's pick-up tag at dismissal.
- Clean the room after all kids have been dismissed.
