WHAT YOU SAY:

"As you work on your 'received with open arms' craft, we are going to think about a story that Jesus told. In this story, the younger son took all the money his father had given him and left home. He used the money to buy whatever he wanted, when he wanted it. A famine came, and there was very little food. The younger son had no money left and no food to eat. He became so desperate that he began to work feeding pigs. He was so very hungry that he actually wanted to eat the slop he gave to the pigs. The younger son finally realized his mistake, but he thought he would need to earn his way back to his father's house. He probably practiced his speech all the way home. But when he approached his father's house, his father ran to him and welcomed him with open arms. So remember, God celebrates when we come to Him, no matter what we've done. He is a forgiving father who loves us and forgives us no matter what."

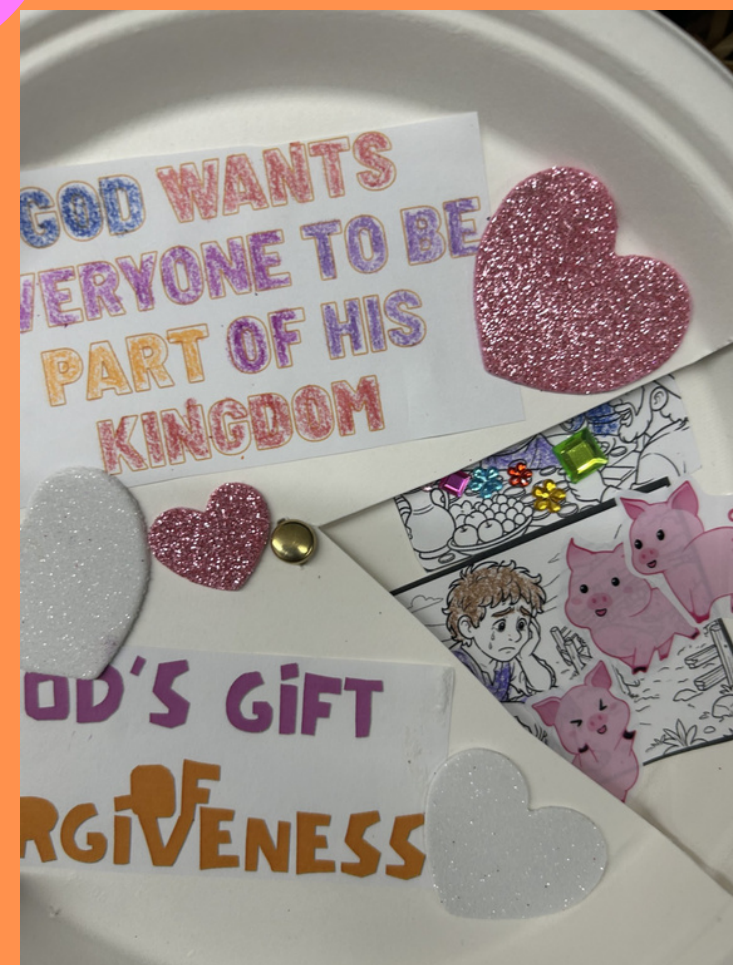
Glue the two texts onto the plate that goes on top.
