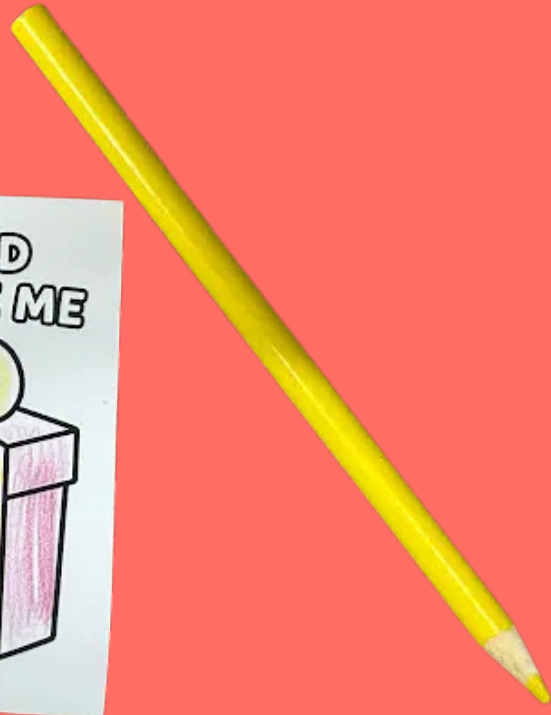
Stick the coins to the money bag.

5



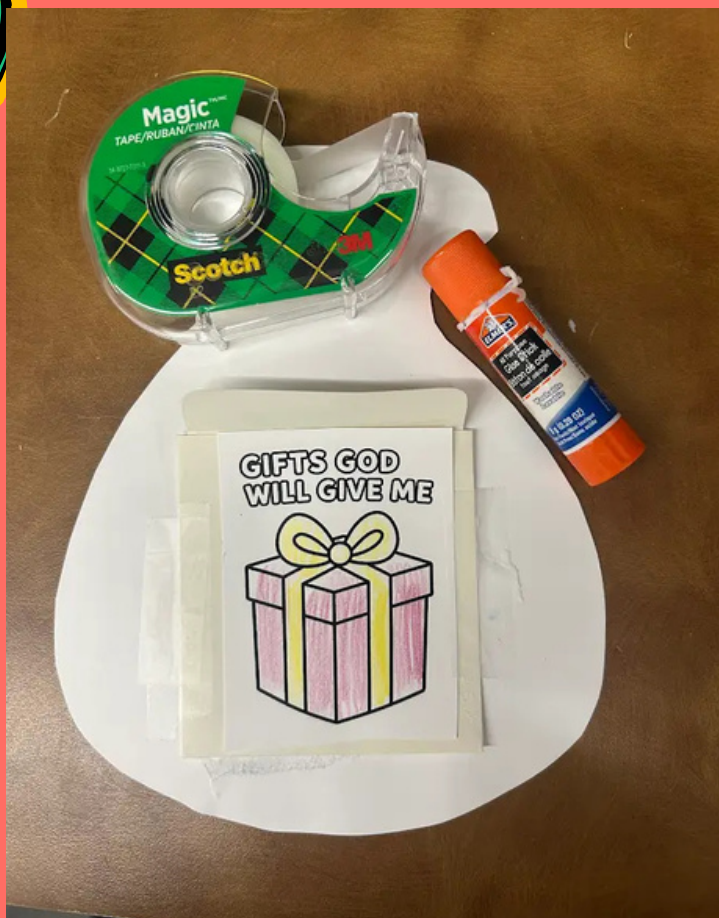
Colour the cutout as shown in the picture.
