CRAFT: Forgiving Heart

WHAT YOU SAY:

"As you work on your "forgiving heart" craft, we are going to think about a story that Jesus told about how God is like a kind king who completely erased a massive debt we could never pay. When we trust Jesus and choose to follow Him, God wipes away our bad choices, sets us free, and asks us to pass that same endless forgiveness on to others. Forgiving someone doesn't mean that what they did was okay, nor does it mean you have to stay friends or let them keep hurting you—if you feel unsafe, you should always tell a trusted adult.

Instead, forgiveness is choosing to let go of anger so your heart doesn't become bitter, and trusting God to handle the situation. It isn't a feeling, but a choice you make with God's help that shows His loving heart to the world and helps His kingdom grow."

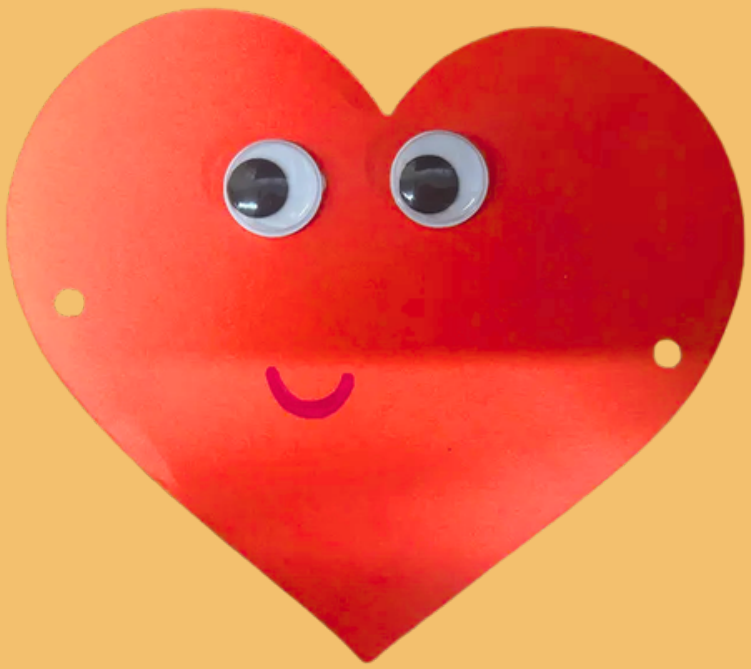
Stick the Band-Aids onto

4



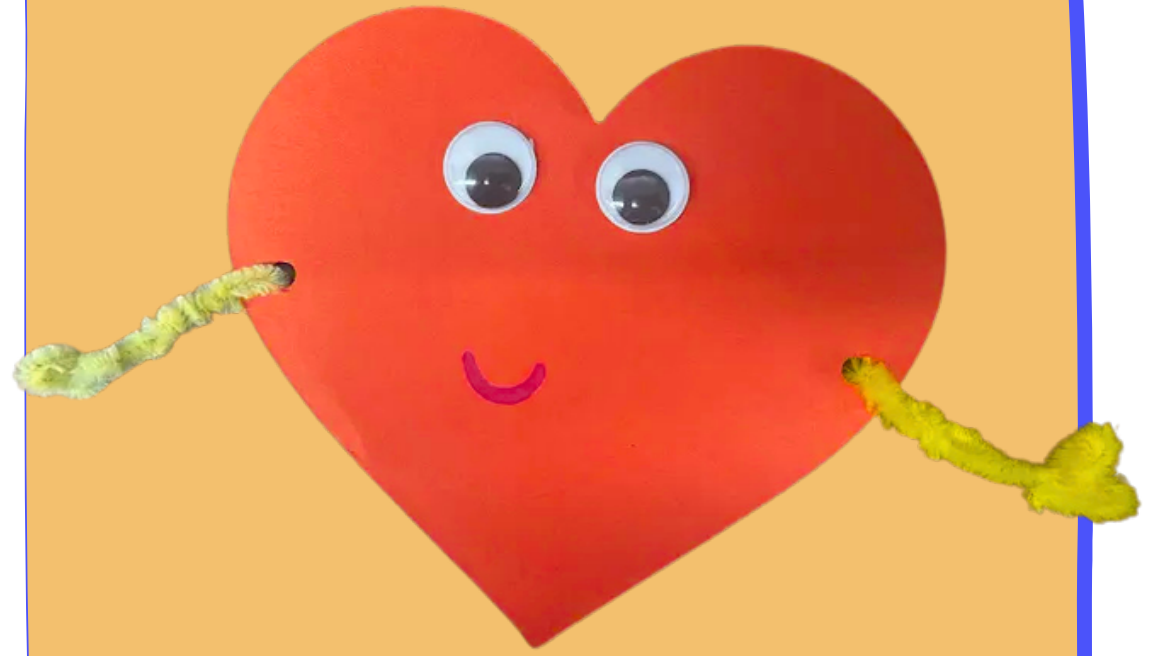
Place the Jesus
