WHAT YOU SAY:

"As you work on your 'Lost and Found' craft, we are going to think about a story that Jesus told. It's about a shepherd who had 100 sheep, but noticed that one of them was missing. In this story, the shepherd could have decided to leave the lost sheep on its own. After all, he still had 99 other sheep left! But the shepherd loved every single one of his sheep, and he cared deeply for them. So, he went out into the wild and searched everywhere until he found the lost sheep. When he finally found it, he was so joyful that he put the sheep on his shoulders and carried it all the way home.

The story that Jesus told shows us exactly how God feels about each one of us. We all sin, and that sin separates us from God. But Jesus paid for our sin, making a way for us to come back home to Him and receive God's forgiveness.

While you work on your craft, remember that Jesus always leaves the 99 to come find the one. That is how special and precious you are to Him!"
