'Come and follow me. ... I will send you out to fish for people.'

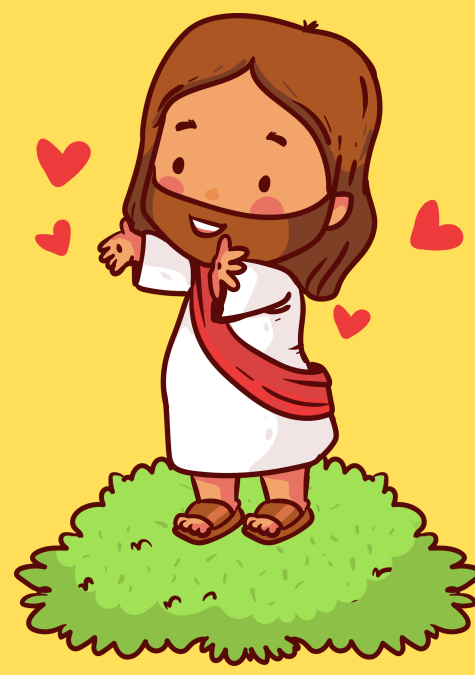

Put the gems inside the envelope.
