ENGAGE IN EVERYDAY MOMENTS TOGETHER

Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say: "Good morning! Jesus loves you so much! I wonder who we can tell about Jesus today?"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, help [name of child] and me go and tell everyone everywhere the good news that Jesus is alive and He wants to be their friend forever."

Drive Time

While on the go, take turns naming people that you see. Talk about how you can tell all of them about Jesus!



Bath Time

As you bathe your child, sing the following words to the tune of "Wheels on the Bus": "Jesus wants to be your friend forever, friend forever, friend forever. Jesus wants to be your friend forever because Jesus loves you."
