YOUTH CONTENT COORDINATORS

We are looking for youth passionate about Centennial to help create content for the church! We have a few different roles youth can be a part of, all youth are invited to do more than one role at one time or another!

Photographers: These youth would come to Centennial Events/worship to take photos & videos that we can use for promotional purposes. The only requirement is that these youth have phones that they can take photos with. Centennial will provide name tags with "Centennial Photographer" so folks at the event know the youth are there to take photos. We will create a google folder that will be very easy to upload photos to after the event.

Journalists: We now have a monthly newsletter that comes out the first Saturday of the month full of reflections on the amazing things going on at Centennial! Youth are invited to write articles for the newsletter as often as they would like. This could be an article about an event you took photos at or went to, an article about what the youth are up to, or a reflective piece on something you love about Centennial! Article topics can be assigned or you are welcome to pitch an idea, but the topic needs to be approved by Pastor Lauren and the Director of Communications & Church Administration, Annika.

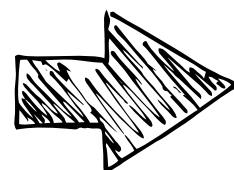
Social Media Specialists: This role isn't going to be active right away, but we would love for youth who are passionate about social media marketing to be involved in our strategy on Instagram! This could be youth helping create the content by taking videos, interviewing people, editing videos, or pitching ideas to Annika for what they think would be fun for social media!

What is the commitment? We know our youth are so busy and are involved with so much more than just Centennial so this is flexible and based on their availability! As of now the role we will be prioritizing the most are the photographers as we want to secure some youth to take pictures at big events like Welcome Sunday, Trunk or Treat, Christmas Eve, etc. We will either need parents to come to events with their youth or if the parents cannot attend we can secure an adult volunteer to supervise.

What do I get out of it? This is a title you can put on your resume/college applications as a regular volunteer role. Also if your school requires service hours we are more than happy to fill out any form or provide any documentation that says you served at Centennial.
