Welcome to Hopewell! We are Glad You are Here!!

Romans 8:18

"For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us."

There are certain verses in the Word of God that seem to shine brighter when life becomes darker. There are passages that become especially precious when we walk through valleys, endure disappointments, face sickness, battle grief, or carry burdens that seem too heavy to bear. Romans 8:18 is one of those verses.

The Apostle Paul writes these words under the inspiration of the Holy Spirit. As I began to meditate on this verse, I realized that Paul is not speaking as a man who has lived an easy life. He is not sitting in comfort. He is not speaking from a palace. He is not speaking from a life free of hardship. This is a man who knew suffering firsthand. Paul knew what it was like to be misunderstood. He knew what it was like to be falsely accused. He knew what it was like to be beaten with rods until his body bled. He knew what it was like to be imprisoned for simply preaching the Gospel. He knew what it was like to be shipwrecked, rejected, and persecuted.

Yet after enduring all of that, he did not become bitter. He did not throw in the towel. He did not quit. Instead, he looked at all the pain, all the suffering, all the tears, and declared, "I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us." The word "reckon" means to calculate. It means to consider carefully. It means to weigh one thing against another. Paul is saying, "I've looked at both sides of the equation. I've examined the suffering, and I've examined the glory. I've put the pain on one side of the scale and eternity on the other side, and after careful consideration there is absolutely no comparison." He is simply saying that what God has prepared for His children is so magnificent, so overwhelming, so eternal, and so glorious that every trial of this life will eventually seem insignificant beside it. What a blessing for the best is yet to come. May we keep looking ahead.

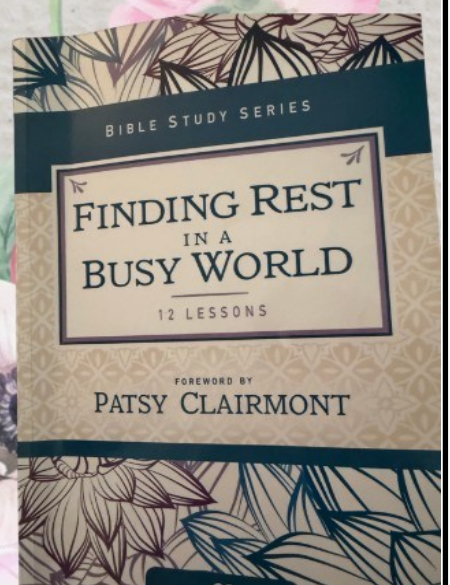

Rebecca "Rozie" Hansen graduated from **Broken Moon Learning Center** in May 2026.

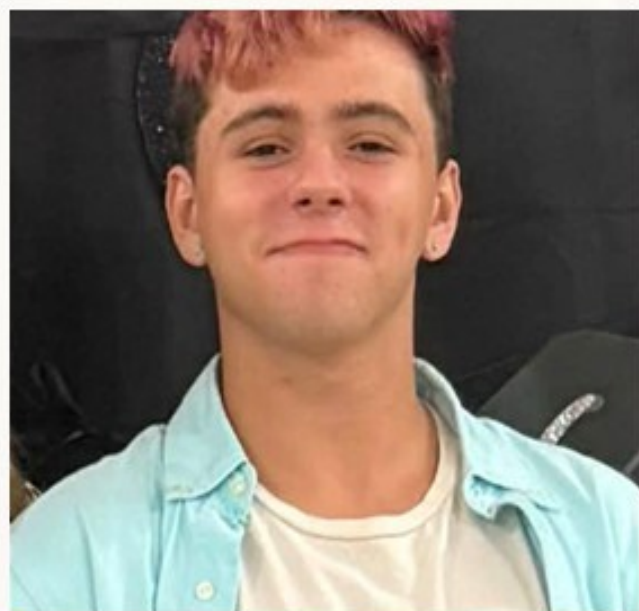

Getting Started
