

Welcome to Hopewell! We are Glad You are Here!!

As we read (Exodus 15:22-27) I want you to imagine for a moment what it must have been like to stand on the shore of the Red Sea. Behind you, the enemy is coming—Pharaoh and his army, the strongest nation on earth, chasing after you. The water stretches out in front of you, and there is no bridge, no boat, no way forward...except God.

And then, in an instant, God opens a path through that impossible sea. The waters stand up like walls on either side, dry ground appears under your feet, and you walk through. The enemy is drowned. You are free. You are delivered. You are redeemed!

Can you see it? Can you hear it? And as soon as the people of Israel get to the other side, what do they do? They sing! They lift up their voices to the God who delivered them. And it is not a quiet song, church—it is a song of victory. A song of power. A song of joy that could not be silenced. But here is what we often forget: just because God delivers us from one thing, it does not mean life gets easier. Just because the Red Sea is behind us does not mean the desert will disappear. Just because God saves us does not mean He removes testing from our lives. And that is exactly where we find Israel in Exodus 15:22–27. They are redeemed, they are singing—but the journey is not over. They are walking into a wilderness. Three days without water. And when they finally find water, it is bitter. And the people complain. They murmur. They struggle.

Church, that is a picture of life with God. That is a picture of every believer at some point: delivered but tested, redeemed but learning, saved but still growing. And it is in that wilderness—in that testing—that God shows us something more. Something that transforms. Something that changes bitter waters into sweet. Something that prepares us for Elim—the place of rest, provision, and fruitfulness. While they were complaining at Marah, God had 12 wells waiting for them ahead. While they were standing at the bitter waters, God had 70 palm trees waving in the desert breeze. Before you ever reach your Elim, God has already dug the wells.
