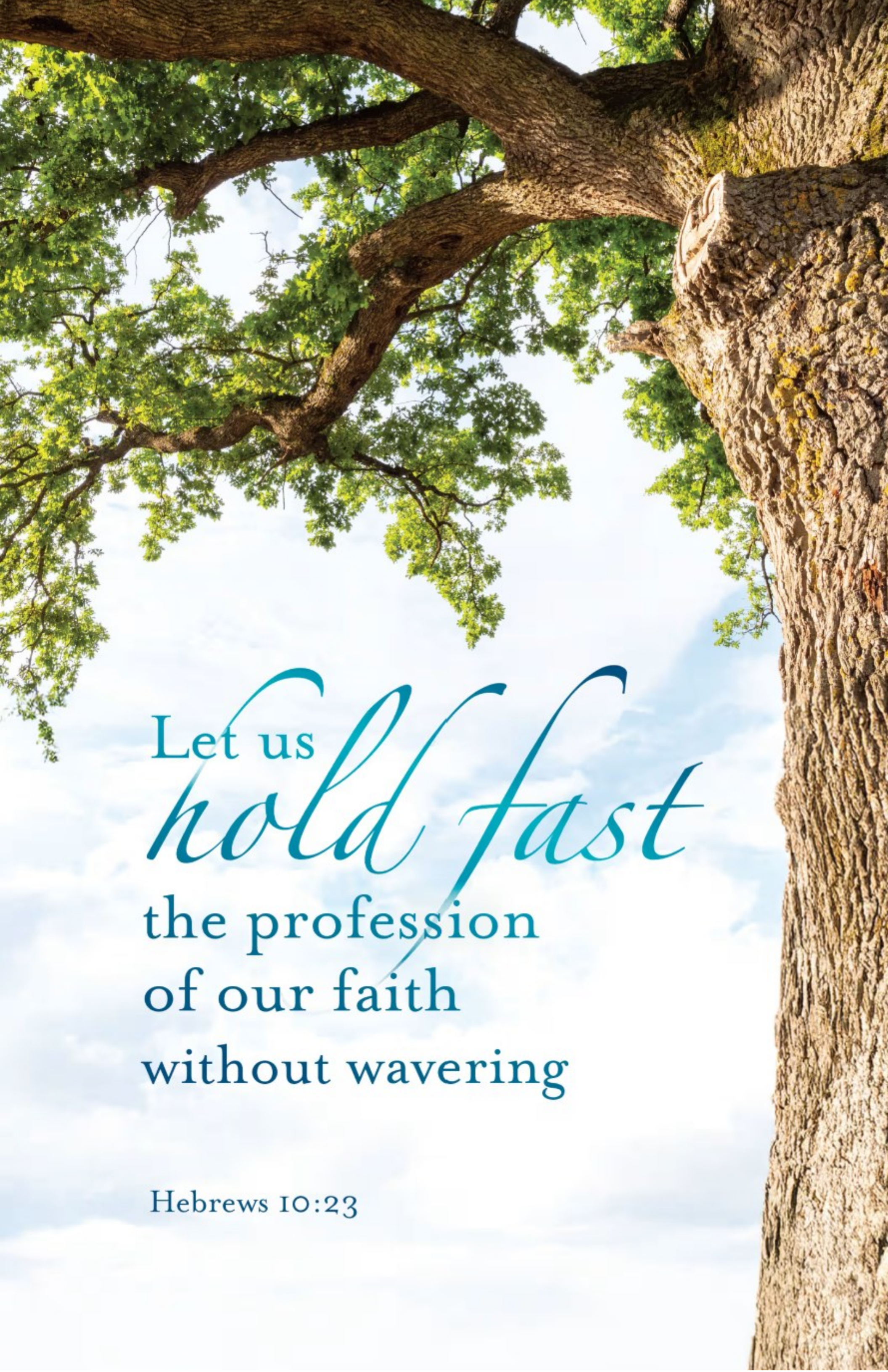

Welcome to Hopewell! We are Glad You are Here!!

I have been pondering this morning on these three encouraging verses found in Psalm 37:23-25 where it says, "The steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord: and he delighteth in his way. Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down: for the Lord upholdeth him with His hand. I have been young, and now am old; yet have I not seen the righteous forsaken, nor his seed begging bread."

What a powerful message from our Lord this morning. Being in the will of God does not mean that every road will be easy. The Bible never promised us a life without valleys. Jesus never told us there would be no storms. He never promised that everybody would treat us right. He never promised that our families would never disappoint us. He never promised that we would never cry. But He did promise, "I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee." That means when the road gets rough, God is still there. When the tears start falling, God is still there. When people walk away, God is still there. When you don't understand what He is doing, God is still there. David may have been walking away from Jerusalem in 2 Samuel 16, but he was not walking away from the presence of God. And sometimes the greatest testimony we can have is not that we never went through anything. Sometimes the greatest testimony is: "I went through it, but God went through it with me." You may not understand the road, but trust the One who does. You may not understand the season, but trust the God who controls the seasons. You may not understand why He allowed it, but you can still trust His heart when you cannot trace His hand.

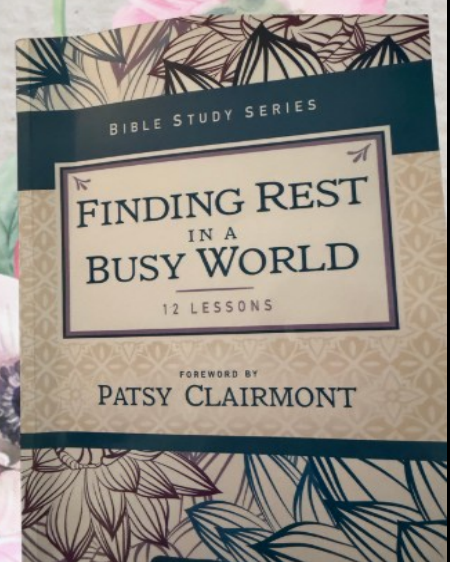

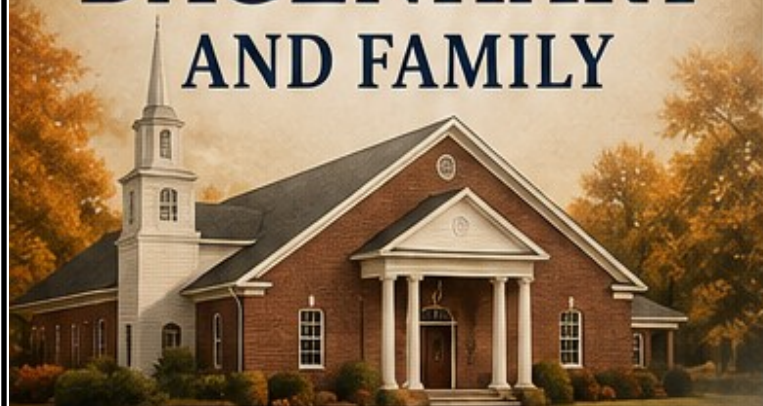
