Why is the Trinity an essential part of Christianity? How does God being triune inform the things we believe about his love, care, kindness and grace? What is one way God being triune can change the way you interact with him?

How do you currently experience your relationship with God? Is it close to the Father/child picture? What could grow or change in you to make it more so?

Of the three things we discussed (honor, access, safety), which is the most meaningful for you? Most difficult to accept/understand? Why is that and what does it look like to engage in these things? How might fully embracing all three of these things change the way you interact with God?
