## Study Questions

Before answering these questions, take some time to read the passage from the sermon together or on your own.

What did this sermon tell us about God?

What did this sermon tell us about us as people?

What did you hear in this sermon that applied the most to your own life?

Is there a group or person that you struggle to see as being invited to Jesus' table the same way you are? Who is it? Why do you feel that way? How can you grow through that and see them at Jesus' table with you?

Talk about a time in your life where you forgave someone by paying whatever debt they owed you. How does that experience help grow your love and appreciation for the forgiveness Jesus has shown you?

Are you more like Simon or the woman? What parts of Simon do you see in yourself? The woman? What are some practical things you can do to become more away of your brokenness? More humble? What are you holding back that you need to surrender?
